Practically speaking, you will:

- Establish, foster and manage relationships with key municipal, provincial and federal regulatory bodies to promote HRAI training and certification programs.
- Participate in the development and revision of relevant national and international HVACR standards and codes. This entails both direct participation on standards and codes committees (and coordinating the participation on committees by member volunteers) to ensure the interests of HRAI members are represented.
- Stay current on relevant technologies and standards issues and prepare technical communications, updates and reports for applicable staff and members as needed.
- Provide technical support, consultation for HRAI members and staff including the education department and instructors regarding building, energy and environmental standards, regulations, course content, software etc.
- Provide technology and content solutions for training materials and delivery methodologies.
- Work with both the education and sales and marketing departments on promotion of technical materials and training for the industry and building officials.

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To be successful in this role, you should have:

- A post-secondary degree/diploma in engineering, engineering technology, building sciences, environmental studies or other related field.
- Two to five years' experience in engineering, building sciences, or an HVACR-related field.
- Strong written communication skills (some evidence of this may be requested).
